### Summary of Motions:

- **Approval of Minutes:** The Statewide Executive Board (SWEB) voted to approve the minutes from the March 12, 2016 meeting.

SEIU Local 668 members from all over Pennsylvania came to Harrisburg on Monday, June 27 to advocate for an on-time budget that fairly funds human services, and for a \$15 minimum wage. Throughout the day, State and Local Unit members spoke with more than 30 legislators/legislative staff members on these and budget-related Shop issues, and participated in a televised rally for a fair budget organized by our friends at the Pennsylvania Budget and Policy Center.
